Subject: Deputation demanding immediate steps to ensure safety and security within the Campus Premises

Respected Sir,

We, the Students' Federation of India (SFI) Technology Campus Unit, submit this deputation to express our deep anguish and serious concern over the rising incidents of violence and sexual assault across campuses in West Bengal and the country.

The horrific gang rape at R.G. Kar Medical College, the incident of sexual assault and rape at South Calcutta Law College, and the recent case at I.Q. City Medical College, Durgapur, have exposed a disturbing trend of institutional neglect and systemic failure. Adding to this, the South Asian University (SAU), New Delhi sexual assault incident has once again shown how the criminal negligence and suppression of justice by authorities can allow perpetrators to act with impunity and destroy the sense of safety among students.

Let this stand as a firm reminder to the University administration that any such negligence here will not be tolerated by the students. The SFI Technology Campus Unit will not remain silent if the administration chooses inaction over responsibility.

We have repeatedly witnessed outsider lumpen elements entering our campus premises, attempting to create unrest, threaten students, and disrupt the academic environment. These incidents, coupled with the broader pattern of violence in educational spaces, make it clear that the current security measures at the Technology Campus are grossly inadequate.

We therefore demand immediate and visible action on the following points:-

1. Full Scale CCTV surveillance coverage - across all areas of the campus, including entry and exit gates, libraries, canteens, and secluded corridors ensuring zero blind spot.
2. Deployment of trained and unbiased security personnel at all gates maintaining a round-the-clock presence.
3. Strict restriction of of outsider entry
4. Immediate strengthening and activation of the Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) with student representatives (elected).
5. Installation of emergency alert systems and campus helplines. 2/3
6. Regular gender-sensitisation workshops and participation of staff, teachers and students.

We make it absolutely clear that administration silence or inaction in the face of growing insecurity will amount to complicity. The University must not wait for a tragedy to occur before acting.
